An Enduring Power of Attorney (EPA) is a legal document that allows you to select who will be responsible for making important decisions on your behalf due to sickness or an injury if you are unable to. A property and financial assets EPA covers decisions about money and assets and can be put into effect at any time. A personal care and welfare EPA covers decisions about your health, accommodation, and care.
